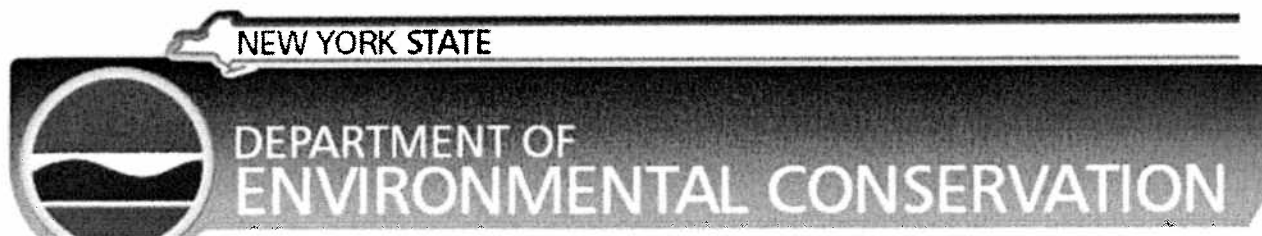


transportation and immigration. Overall, the project would provide various year round offerings and experiences, including restaurants, entertainment venues, retail outlets, cultural attractions, public spaces and increased access to Lake Erie and the Buffalo River appealing to a wide demographic of visitors and residents. The project would create a series of walkable "neighborhood districts" which would be defined by the historical street grid, expansive public access areas and convenient, yet unobtrusive vehicle parking options.

It is anticipated that Empire State Development Corporation (ESDC) and the Erie Canal Harbor Development Corporation (ECHDC), a subsidiary of ESDC, would adopt a General Project Plan (GPP). The Proposed Action would also involve: disposition by the various state and local agencies of certain owned property to ECHDC within the Project Area; Public Authorities Control Board approval; and provision of state funding for Project elements. 

NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF DRAFT GENERIC ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CANAL SIDE PROJECT, BUFFALO, NEW YORK

Pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") (Article 8 of the New York State Environmental Conservation Law) and its implementing regulations (6 NYCRR Part 617), a Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement ("DGEIS") has been prepared for the Canal Side Project, located along the Buffalo River near the southern terminus of the NFTA Metro Rail system at the foot of Main Street. The Project area is generally bounded on the north by Upper Terrace, Exchange Street

and Perry Boulevard; on the east by Washington Street and Seymour H. Knox III Plaza; on the south by Perry Street and the Buffalo River; and, on the west by Erie Street, Marine Drive and Pearl and Commercial Streets. The New York State Urban Development Corporation, d/b/a Empire State Development Corporation ("ESDC"), is acting as Lead Agency for purposes of SEQRA. The Canal Side Project would comprise \$300 million in public/private investment consisting of 1,075,000 square feet of commercial (retail, lodging, office), cultural and residential space that would be designed to emphasize downtown Buffalo's connection to the Lake Erie waterfront. Anchored by a Bass Pro Outdoor World Store, the proposed Project would provide various year-round offerings and experiences including restaurant, entertainment venues, retail outlets, cultural attractions, public spaces and increased access to the Buffalo River. This project has been classified as a Type I action pursuant to SEQRA.
